1 SECTION 2. Selection of officers. -- Upon organization of 2 said joint legislative commission, by majority vote, one (1) of 3 their members shall be chosen as chairman, another of their 4 membres shall be chosen vice-chairman and another of their mem-5 bers shall be chosen as secretary.

<u>SECTION 3. Purposes. --</u> It shall be the purpose of this
commission to study several areas including but not limited to:
A. Education of the driving public to the concept of bicycles on the highway.

B. More effective road maintainence with bicycles in mind,
such as repair of potholes, modification of or marking of drainage grates.

C. Designation of bicycle routes on our present highways,
marked with signs and white lines.

15 \checkmark D. Construction of accessible and secure bicycle parking 16 facilities at all public buildings with the state encouraging the 17 public sector, bus and train depots to provide such facilities. 18 \checkmark E. Implementation of educational programs in bicycle safety 19 through the public school system, and preparation of a bicycle 20 safety fact sheet to be enclosed with driver's license and motor 21 vehicle registration mailings.

22 \checkmark F. Reviewing the state motor vehicle code with reference to 23 bicycle awareness.

G. Designation and/or modification of public transportation vehicles (trains, buses, airlines ferries, etc.) to accomodate the transportation of bicycles.

27 \checkmark H. Conversion of abandoned railroad and canal rights of way 28 into recreational trails.

I. Preparation of a national plan for bicycle hotel devel-opment.

J. Promotion of bicycle riding as an alternate
energy-saving method of transportation and also as a major concession to physical fitness.
